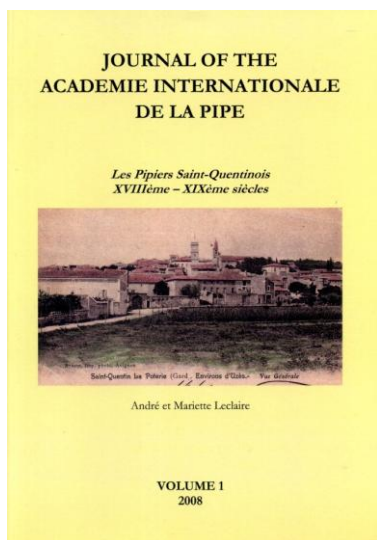


# The Académie Internationale de la Pipe

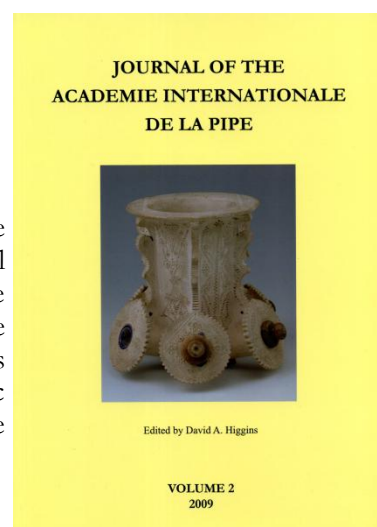


## JAIP Volume 1

The first *Journal of the Académie Internationale de la Pipe* (JAIP) is devoted to an archaeological study of the important clay pipe making industry of *Saint-Quentin la Poterie*, France. The main text is in French but there is an extensive English summary. Lavishly illustrated, this volume provides a valuable case study for anyone researching material culture and it will be especially useful for those studying trade to and from the Mediterranean region. 105 pages; black and white images.

## JAIP Volume 2

The second *Journal of the Académie Internationale de la Pipe* (JAIP) is more typical of the Academy's journals with a range of papers presented. The content of this second journal falls in to two sections – the clay pipe country summaries, comprising a study of the state of knowledge regarding the clay tobacco pipe industry in 19 different countries. The second part of this volume comprises a series of papers on different research topics including cheroot holders, ember pots, advertising pipes as well as a paper on the Civic Company's pattern book with a discussion on the way in which the briar trade functioned. 196 pages; images in black and white and colour.



## AIP Yearbooks and Annales

From 1994 to 2008 the *Académie* produced a small colour publication with notes and short articles by its members. Some of the later issues of these Year Books (1998-2008) are still available. Priced at €7 (£6) each including post and packing.

2001 to 2004 – available in English, French or German

2005/6 and 2007/8 – available as bi-lingual volumes (French/English)

The *Académie* Annales were published in two languages – French and English – in a single volume and contain members' contact details, reports from meetings and conferences, and details of any new publications. The Annales are no longer produced but a small number of back issues are still available.
